1. Discussion on the millage rate of the Town for fiscal year 2021-2022. ***Brandon Perkins, Town Manager***

Ms. Beach informed everyone that the item was the third public hearing for the 2021-2022 millage rate, and that the adoption would take place during the following 7:00 pm meeting. She briefly explained a pie chart and stated that Tyrone residents pay a majority of their taxes to Fayette County and to Fayette County Board of Education. A small percentage was allocated directly to the Town. She shared that the public hearings were advertised and that the purposed 2.889 millage rate, if approved, would be the same for fourteen years in a row. She added that if your home was valued at \$350,000, your taxes would increase by \$21.94. The average non-homestead value was \$325,000 which would increase citizen's tax by \$20.67 for the year.

Mayor Dial opened the public hearing for anyone that wished to speaking in opposition. No one spoke.

Mayor Dial shared that the adoption would take place during the 7:00 pm meeting.
